WHO WE ARE

FamilyAid Boston is dedicated to preventing and ending family homelessness, one family at a time. Since 1916, we have given homeless parents and children shelter, housing, and hope.

FamilyAid Boston's programs provide families with the support and resources they need at every step of the journey from homelessness to housing. Our programs are united by a focus on compassionate case management. Each family receives individualized counseling and support from qualified social service professionals. Case managers help families address the reasons why they became homeless, a process that empowers families to remain stable and housed long after they complete our programs.

SHELTER

FamilyAid Boston provides emergency shelter to homeless parents and children at any time of the day or night. Once a family is placed in safe shelter, a care team including a case manager, employment specialist, and housing search specialist works with them to develop their resources and a make a plan to return to safe, stable housing as soon as possible.



FamilyAid Boston offers the only **24/7/365** emergency shelter resource for homeless families in the City of Boston.

HOUSING

FamilyAid Boston provides affordable housing for homeless families through a range of programs, including agency owned and operated housing. Families in our housing programs pay an affordable rent and receive ongoing support from their care team to ensure that they remain stable and continue to grow and succeed over the long term.



Whenever possible, FamilyAid Boston works to help families before they become homeless, providing prevention and stabilization services to more than **400** parents and children annually.
