

Housing Placement Specialist

The Housing Placement Specialist provides housing search services to a caseload of homeless families. The Specialist works collaboratively with each family and their case manager to assess and identify the family's needs and barriers to safe stable housing. The Specialist conducts housing search with consideration to each's family's housing plan, and coordinates placement and moves as quickly as possible.

The successful candidate will have a, Bachelor's degree or related experience, 1-3 years professional social work desired, and demonstrated success in affordable housing search and placement desired. English and Spanish preferred. Ability to work in both office and field-based settings with a diverse, homeless population. Flexibility and compassion essential.

With a mission to empower parents facing homelessness to secure and sustain housing and build foundations for their children's futures, FamilyAid is on a fast track to curb the region's growing homelessness crisis. Its nationally recognized homelessness prevention, diversion, emergency shelter, and supportive affordable housing programs serve more than 2,000 children and parents each year.
